

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold a public hearing on Thursday, **November 2, 2017** in the Board of County Commissioners' Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at **9:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining the following:

- A. **Shoreline Substantial Development Permit Application PL 15-0302** for the Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company LLC. The project includes additions and upgrades to Tesoro's existing Anacortes facility in order to produce 15,000 barrels per day of mixed xylenes and to supply cleaner local transportation fuels. Mixed xylene is a compound found in gasoline, and is used to make clothing, plastics and other synthetic products. Tesoro anticipates approximately five additional vessels a month would be needed to support the production and shipment of mixed xylenes.

Tesoro has applied for a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit in accordance with the Washington State Shoreline Management Act and the Skagit County Shoreline Management Master Program. The portion of the project that is within shoreline jurisdiction includes a Dock Safety Unit (DSU), which would be located on the existing refinery wharf, and a 3-inch natural gas line that would be constructed to run from the DSU to the Vapor Combustion Unit, which would be located in the upland area of the refinery. Both are a part of the proposed Marine Vapor Emission Control System.

The project is located at 10200 West March Point Road, within a portion of Section 21 and a portion of Section 28, Township 35 North, Range 2 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington (P32990 and P32989). Staff Contact: Betsy Stevenson
